Many thanks to all who participated in the Fish Fry this year. It was a joy to bring back indoor dining and the fellowship that comes with it. The sales were split about equally between dine-in and drive-thru, roughly 450 meals each. The event was also an economic success, generating the most cash sales, the most donations, and the highest net profit of any Fish Fry in the history of St. Bavo Parish.
